Chairman's Statement



Redmond O'Donoghue, Chairman

At the beginning of 2010, the sentiment amongst tourism operators was that the year ahead would once again bring challenges. However, many expressed greater confidence about the immediate future and at the very least were expecting greater stability for the coming year. Unfortunately, the year did not meet such expectations.

Indeed, by the end of the year, many tourism businesses had walked the tightrope between paring back prices and offering good value while ensuring that their businesses remained viable. Despite being an incredibly punishing year for tourism, most businesses survived through a mixture of innovation, experience and sacrifice.

They say that you can tell the character of a person by how they cope with adversity. This observation can also be applied to the tourism sector over the last few years. Tourism operators have proven to be resilient, flexible and innovative in dealing with the economic challenge of a recession. The tourism sector has also managed the neat trick of maintaining – as best as possible – the quality of what we offer, while making the necessary savings and changes to trade through the current down-turn.

As a destination, Ireland has also managed to maintain and maybe enhance the friendliness of its welcome. With additional State investment, tourism infrastructure continues to improve. We also now have a Festivals and

Sports Calendar that is action-packed and spans the year.

So, we have a good quality product, we have better infrastructure and we are better value than before. We know where our most productive overseas target markets are and what needs to be done. So, with all these advantages, the tourism sector has the ability to bounce back quickly, if given a fair wind.

As we leave 2010 behind us and look forward to 2011, there are signs of green shoots. The key to growth lies in developing more overseas business thereby generating much needed foreign earnings and sustaining jobs. There are signs, somewhat tentative, of an upturn in the global economy.

This augurs well for job creation in a country where unemployment is currently a great cause for concern. Tourism and Hospitality is a highly labour intensive industry, accounting for one in ten jobs, often in parts of the country not well serviced by other industries. The importance of the 'personal touch' will ensure it must remain a staff-intensive sector and, if we experience any significant upswing in overseas numbers and activity, the potential for additional jobs will be there. Indeed, Fáilte Ireland is already identifying and supporting new job opportunities through a variety of business start-ups.

In the future, we will work with the industry on all the

"push" and "pull" factors that grow this sector. We will be working to help them 'push' greater numbers of visitors to our shores through tailored programmes which help businesses to close overseas sales. Fáilte Ireland will be working all year round to maximise all the necessary 'pull' factors – the full on experience of all there is to see and do here – to ensure that we get that rise in visitor numbers that the tourism product in this country deserves.

On behalf of the Authority, I would like to thank Shaun Quinn and all his team in Fáilte Ireland for their commitment and professionalism in supporting the tourism industry throughout 2010.

I would like to express my appreciation to the former Minister for Tourism, Culture and Sport, Ms Mary Hanafin, for her support to the tourism sector throughout her tenure in 2010. I also would like to wish the recently appointed Minister, Mr Leo Varadkar TD, and Minister of State, Michael Ring TD, the best in the tourism portfolio – we look forward to working closely with them.

Tourism in recent times has become more valued again as an economic player. This industry generates over 180,000 jobs and almost €5 billion in revenue and, as such, I believe it is a vital national asset. Tourism has a central role to play in this country's economic regeneration and Fáilte Ireland will continue to press this case in the years ahead.

Chief Executive's Review 2010

TOURISM PERFORMANCE

The last few years have been among the most difficult and challenging for Irish tourism in a generation. As a result of the adverse economic conditions in our key international markets and the severe recession affecting the Irish economy, Ireland's tourism performance has declined in each of the three years since 2007 - following a previous period of six years of sustained and significant growth.

The downturn in tourism has also prompted a significant shift in Fáilte Ireland strategy and operations to ensure that the organisation remained acutely relevant to the needs of tourism enterprises, the vast majority of which continued to experience trading and operational difficulty.

Overseas visitor numbers for 2010 were estimated at 5.9m - 11% less than in 2009. Tourism foreign exchange earnings also fell in 2010 by 12% to a total of €3.4 billion for the same 12 month period.

Within the overall downward trend, visitor numbers from Britain were down a significant 11% on 2009, primarily due to weak demand and to the weakness of sterling against the euro, while arrivals from Mainland Europe fell by 15% with most of the major European markets registering double digit declines.

The news from the long haul markets was less challenging, and the falls less steep. Visitors from North

America were down 4% while visitors from the other long-haul markets grew by 5%. The number of domestic trips taken by Irish residents in 2010 was down slightly on 2009 at 8 million trips, with expenditure down 10% to €1.3 billion reflecting the contraction of disposable income in the economy.

In the absence of official figures for domestic holidays, secondary data sources indicate that the number of holiday trips may have been similar to 2009, following the disruption to travel patterns caused by Icelandic Volcanic Ash.

Customer satisfaction with the Irish tourism product remained high in these challenging times. The number of visitors who said they would definitely recommend Ireland was very high and peaked at 88% in 2010, the highest level in the past five years.

Furthermore, more than one in five (23%) visitors from abroad anticipated coming back within the next year and over half of all visitors (52%) envisaged a repeat visit in the next few years. For 95% of overseas holidaymakers, a holiday in Ireland either exceeded or matched their expectations and 98% said they would recommend a holiday in Ireland to family and friends. Among domestic holiday takers, overall satisfaction levels also reached 96%.

SUPPORTING COMPETITIVE TOURISM ENTERPRISE

The adverse trading conditions prevailing throughout

the 2010 tourist season dictated that Fáilte Ireland significantly increase its investment in providing practical business supports to individual tourism enterprises experiencing difficulties. By year end, just less than 3,000 *tourism enterprises* received tailored support. The range of services provided encompassed financial restructuring, business mentoring, productivity improvement, sales and marketing, e-business and customer care.

To facilitate this shift in focus, Fáilte Ireland completed a major internal restructuring of its regional operations complemented by training and development of a nationwide executive team interacting with industry clients.

Demand for training interventions to boost productivity within individual businesses was particularly strong as operators struggled to keep enterprises running on a viable basis with fewer staff. In total, Fáilte Ireland provided direct training and development support to some 5,000 *industry employees*, at their place of work, or at one of its regional training centres. Industry demand was such that Fáilte Ireland shifted its emphasis from training new entrants to helping to sustain existing jobs.

Not surprisingly, the growing impact of e-commerce on travel and tourism has fuelled particularly strong demand for enterprise development support in this area. Through our *e-business initiative*, a range of web and social media supports were delivered in 2010 to assist members of the industry in developing their commercial capability through effective online presence. Fáilte Ireland worked with 760 *businesses and 2,250 executives* to review and improve their websites and web functionality through Web Check and Web Check Plus. In addition, 70 *web training programmes* were provided to update and develop 1,200 *managers'*

skills in web development and application and helped 45 *businesses* at start-up stage through the development of a website for their enterprise.

Demand also increased in 2010 for a range of *mentoring services* provided by Fáilte Ireland. Demand was strongest for marketing and e-marketing support on site. A panel of over 50 *mentors* delivered a total of 500 *interventions to 440 businesses*. In addition, some 1,350 *industry executives* participated in our programme of continuous professional development. This was almost twice the level recorded in 2009 and included 24 *senior management participants* graduating from the Fáilte Ireland / Cornell University *Executive Management Programme* who were awarded a certificate in "Strategic Hospitality Management" accredited from Cornell University. In addition, 40 *senior managers from hotels* graduated in May from the Marketing Management in Action programme which was delivered in association with Boston College, Massachusetts.

Over 220 *businesses* participated in our "*Selling Ireland Overseas*" initiative which focused on helping tourism businesses to increase their international focus and win more business from our key overseas markets, in particular the UK, USA, Germany and France.

MARKET DEVELOPMENT

Stimulating Domestic Demand

As a direct consequence of the continued weakness of key overseas markets, Fáilte Ireland invested significantly again in promoting and developing the home holiday market. Our research indicated an increasing level of interest amongst Irish people to holiday at home in the prevailing economic conditions. In response, Fáilte Ireland intensified its efforts with an integrated multi-media Discover Ireland marketing campaign, focusing on national and regional press,



radio, television and online. In total, some €4 million was invested in the campaign and feedback from industry was particularly positive regarding its overall impact on business performance.

Our marketing efforts were complemented again by the implementation of an attractive and compelling programme of *festivals and cultural events* which served to heighten the appeal of many tourist destinations around Ireland. As a major sponsor, Fáilte Ireland continued to invest heavily in festivals and cultural events throughout 2010. A total of €3.8m was awarded to 228 festivals during the year. Our national programme supported 39 *festivals* with an investment of €2.7m and leveraging approximately €29.9 million of direct spend for local economies. Research carried out in 2010 calculated the total combined value of the economic activity generated by festivals in Ireland to be €448 million for the year.

Winning International Business Tourism for Ireland

As the organisation responsible for developing business tourism in Ireland, Fáilte Ireland continued to invest heavily in identifying, attracting and securing more international conferences and meetings for hosting in Ireland. During 2010, we supported 168 *international conferences* accounting for over 83,000 *overseas delegates* to Ireland and a revenue yield of approximately €125 million to the Irish economy.

In 2010, 93 *conference ambassadors* - who promote Ireland as a business venue abroad - were introduced by Fáilte Ireland to the Convention Bureau. In terms of business generation, these ambassadors represent a potential for over 72,000 *delegates with revenue totaling €108m*.

In September, the Convention Centre Dublin officially opened, paving the way for continued and significant growth in business tourism for Ireland. To coincide with the opening, Fáilte Ireland welcomed 120 *top international business tourism buyers* at a "Meet in Ireland" business tourism networking event. Overall, the prospects for this sector of tourism appear bright. Demand is recovering in key markets and Ireland is well placed in terms of supporting infrastructure, while our competitiveness is improving.

Supporting the In-bound Leisure Sector

Ensuring that individual tourism businesses are well placed to exploit a greater share of international tourist markets is now a key priority for Fáilte Ireland. While responsibility for developing our key source markets rests with Tourism Ireland Ltd., our sister agency, it is Fáilte Ireland's responsibility to help tourism operators to 'close the sale'.

During 2010, Fáilte Ireland, coordinated a programme of seven 'meet-the-buyer' type trade workshops. In total, some 923 *Irish tourism businesses* participated in these workshops to meet and conclude business with 480 *key representatives of the international travel trade*. Overall, these events provided some 25,000 *pre-arranged meeting opportunities* for participating Irish businesses.

Hosting and organising the arrangements for international media visiting Ireland to profile the destination for international audiences remains an important but sometimes overlooked activity. For a small destination, experiencing economic difficulties, this activity adds immeasurably to our overall destination marketing efforts for little incremental cost. In 2010, we hosted over 1,300 *journalists from 22 target overseas markets*. They included journalists from



television, radio, newspapers, magazines and online media. These trips resulted in over *5,000 major articles and broadcasts*, with an estimated advertising value of over €200m.

In 2010, Fáilte Ireland also worked with Iarnród Éireann and Tourism Ireland to introduce and implement an incentivised scheme to provide free travel for our older international visitors. The '*Golden Trekker' Scheme*' proved quite popular in its first year with some *15,000 tickets* issued during March to December.

DEVELOPING THE TOURISM PRODUCT

The key to sustainable tourism growth hinges on the ability of a destination to offer the visitor a unique and fully immersive experience. A destination such as Ireland trades on the concept of a unique and special experience as opposed to more generic factors in holiday planning such as sun or snow. Key to this is promoting and supporting the development of high quality, distinctive holiday experiences that will maintain and strengthen important tourism destinations around the country. This will support increased visitor numbers, dwell time and spend which in turn supports profitable businesses, employment and vibrant communities.

Within Fáilte Ireland, a number of our teams work to develop and support the expansion and enhancement of tourist activities, attractions, accommodation and events across the many different sectors of the tourism industry. It is worth observing in passing that we need to maintain a focus on activities, attractions, and events as the key drivers of tourism to Ireland. Whilst food and accommodation are routinely prominent in tourism debate, and indeed are a core determinant of visitor satisfaction, the fact remains that they are seldom the principal drivers of the consumer's decision to come to

Ireland. That decision is much more likely to be influenced by the daytime "things to do and things to see" which are largely encapsulated in the grouping of activities, attractions, and events. This therefore remains a principal focus of our product development programme.

Considerable progress was made during 2010 on implementing Fáilte Ireland's Product Development Strategy, and the Tourism Capital Investment Programme featured strongly within the revised Public Capital Programme for 2010-2016, published by the Government at the end of July. A total of *23 projects* was approved for approximately €37m of grant assistance in 2010.

In selecting these projects, Fáilte Ireland takes care to maximise the economic impact of the tourism assets that exist in certain parts of the country. An example of this is that, in product development terms, the west of the country is considered to have particular strengths in terms of landscape and scenery, walking and cycling, soft adventure, and traditional music and culture. The east and south-east of the country is considered to have particular strengths in history and heritage, houses and gardens, and built heritage more generally. These observations can never be absolute, but in relative terms they have a certain validity. So, in investment practice in 2010, this was evident with an emphasis on projects such as Sliabh Liag, Great Western Greenway, Lee Valley Eco-Park, Tralee and Mizen Head in the West, and in projects such as Boyne Valley Heritage, Viking Triangle, Ferrycarrig Heritage village and Castletown House and Gardens in the East.

It is notable also that projects such as these have a certain "public good" dimension to them. Typically, these projects are supported not as profit generating



business ventures (in and of themselves), but because they serve as key attractors drawing visitors to an area and so generate economic gains which are captured by other businesses in that area. In many respects, these projects represent an investment in "tourism infrastructure" and represent a parallel to more familiar concepts such as investment in "transport infrastructure".

Progress continued into 2010 on the implementation of the National Programme for the Interpretation and Walking Route signage of our *100 most notable Historic Towns*. Works have been completed at 44 of these towns, with downloadable walking trail maps of the towns provided on the Discover Ireland website. In addition, a guidelines document was produced for historic towns and how they can maximize their tourism potential.

HOSPITALITY AND STANDARDS

In 2010 Fáilte Ireland developed a Food Tourism Framework for Ireland which is guided by the vision that Ireland will be recognised by visitors for the availability, quality and value of our local and regional food experiences, evoking a unique sense of place, culture and hospitality.

New classification and categorisation schemes were developed for the Irish Home B&B sector along with a new strategy and brand. In addition, a new Approvals Scheme for the golf sector was implemented with 60 courses approved to date.

A total of *50 new establishments* participated in the Optimus Programme – Fáilte Ireland's service quality programme – and benefited from a range of development interventions including mentoring, training and standards workshops.

Another important strand in terms of hospitality supports is the work Fáilte Ireland undertakes to enhance skills and employment in the industry. An extensive range of education and training programmes is supported in ten Institutes of Technology around the country. These programmes provide industry-relevant training in areas such as culinary skills, restaurant service, bar skills, front office and restaurant management. In 2010, Fáilte Ireland invested €4.3m in building tourism relevant skills for some 1,920 students in the Institute of Technology sector.

POLICY AND FUTURES

During 2010, Fáilte Ireland undertook a variety of research projects and other studies in order to provide a knowledge-based rationale for planning future tourism initiatives.

Four waves of our Tourism Barometer Survey were carried out, measuring industry sentiment in relation to year-to-date performance and future prospects. Continuous measurement of the performance of hotels and other accommodation sectors also took place throughout the year. As well as the continuous profiling of domestic tourists through national surveys, overseas visitor profiling was undertaken through surveys at the major air and sea ports. Work was also commissioned to track the effectiveness of the domestic holiday advertising campaign.

Last year Fáilte Ireland delivered several projects designed to secure pro-tourism outcomes on a range of issues. These included:

- An analysis and briefing paper on excess capacity in the hotel sector



- The development of an evaluation methodology to review performance in key tourism destinations
- A review of cultural tourism and cultural institutions in Ireland
- Guidance to historic towns on how to maximize their tourism potential.

We also worked on collaborative pro-tourism projects with the Restaurants Association of Ireland, the Irish Hotels Federation, Irish Tourist Industry Confederation and a range of national festivals like Galway Arts and Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann. A future oriented study was completed on the medium-term implications for the industry of demographic and other social developments.

TOURISM AND THE ENVIRONMENT

Throughout 2010 Fáilte Ireland continued to place the natural and built environment at the heart of sustainable tourism policy and practice. In fulfilment of our role as a prescribed body under the Planning Acts, Fáilte Ireland made submissions in relation to all eight Regional Planning Guidelines, six county and city development plans, 18 planning applications and 41 Environmental Impact Assessments. In each of these submissions, Fáilte Ireland promoted a sustainable approach to the development of tourism that seeks to protect the asset upon which the industry depends.

The Fáilte Ireland Environment Unit also continued to assist individual tourism businesses in their efforts to reduce both energy consumption and water usage and improve management of their waste more efficiently. In particular, environmental guidelines for the business tourism sector and for equestrian centres were published, and Fáilte Ireland ran a pilot programme in South Kerry which resulted in environmental certification for 55 tourism businesses and the publication of

a Green Guide to the Ring of Kerry. In addition, the summary guide for tourism businesses on reducing their environmental costs was updated.

CONCLUSION

The tourism sector experienced a sharp downturn in 2010 – bringing the industry back to 2002 levels of performance.

That said, we have also become much more competitive as an industry and as a destination. A combination of keen competition between tourism businesses in a climate of weak demand has contributed to a marked improvement in our value for money ratings over the same period as judged by visitors from all markets.

The pace of recovery in overseas visitors to Ireland will be dictated to a large degree by economic factors in our key source markets - Britain, the US, Germany and France. With the exception of Britain, the signals are already positive. Consumer confidence in our key overseas markets is edging upwards and tourism here is beginning to benefit.

Interest in visiting Ireland is growing, our appeal remains strong and we now offer better value than for many years. We cannot take recovery for granted. Fáilte Ireland will continue to work closely with tourism businesses to ensure they are well positioned to fully benefit from any global upturn in tourism and travel.

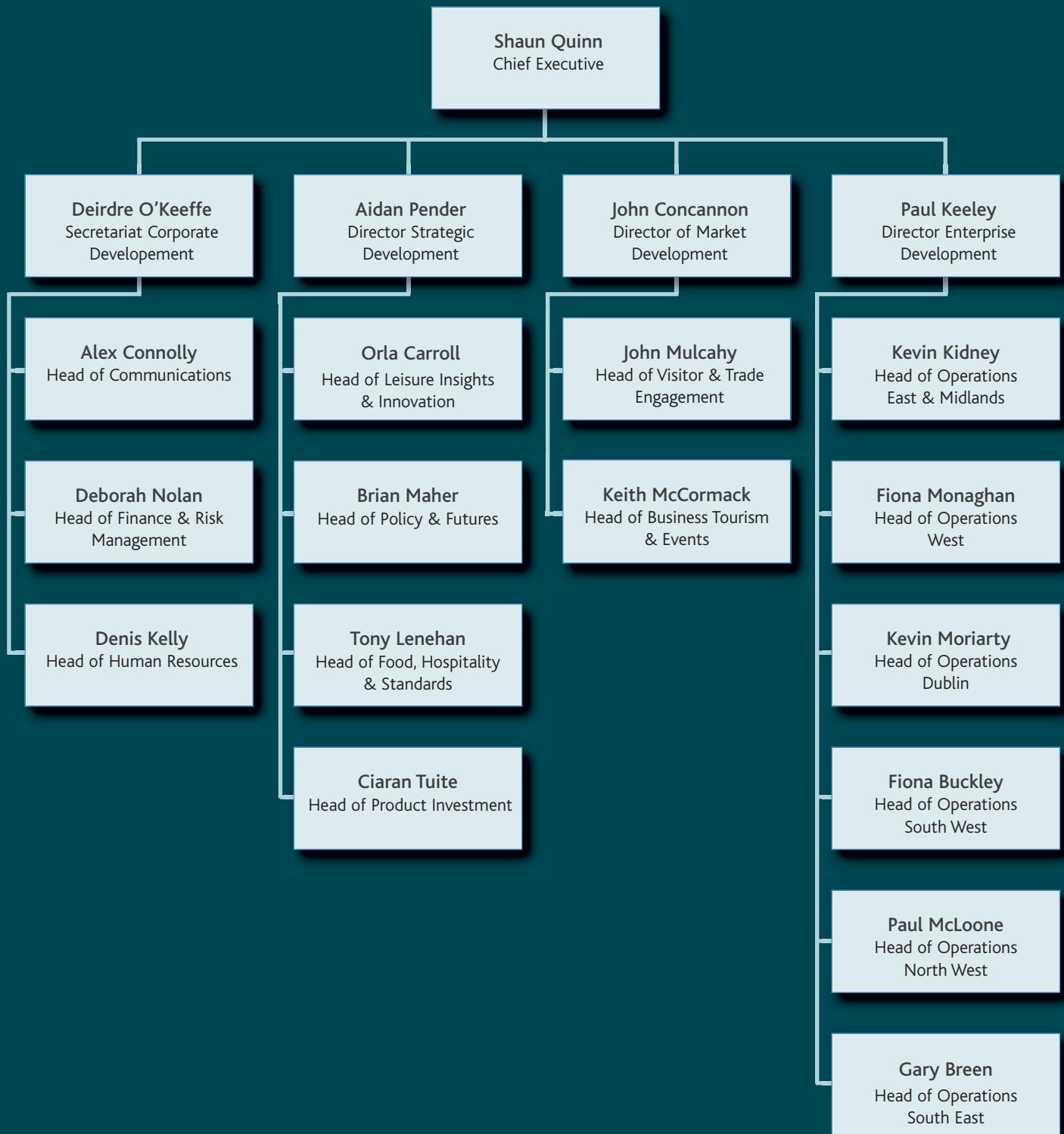

Energy Efficiency Statement

Overview of Energy Usage in 2010

Fáilte Ireland as the National Tourism Development Authority has a broad remit and consequently our demand and usage of energy is very diverse, ranging from full production kitchens in our 3 Training Centres to the supply of energy to our office buildings, light, heat, air conditioning, hot water and office equipment in 54 Discover Ireland Centres/Tourist Information Offices (of which 29 are seasonal), 5 Regional Headquarters and Head Office in Dublin.

In 2010, Fáilte Ireland consumed 3,536 MWh of energy, consisting of:

- 2,220 MWh of electricity;
- 1,316 MWh of fossil fuels, including 1,160 MWh of natural gas, 148 MWh of gasoil and 8 MWh of liquid petroleum gas.

Actions Undertaken in 2010

In 2010 Fáilte Ireland undertook a range of initiatives to improve our energy performance, the largest of which were:

- Our ICT Division consolidated 12 physical servers into a virtualised environment. It is generally estimated that for each physical server decommissioned, the CO₂ savings are equivalent to taking 1 car off the road for a year. Estimated energy savings from this project are 42 MWh electricity savings annually.
- As a bi-product of moving our Fáilte Ireland South East regional headquarters to a more energy efficient premises we were able to achieve savings of an estimated 75 MWh fossil fuels annually. Heating in the new premises is now electrically based, comparing periods of 6 months, the decrease in electricity purchased from one premises to another was 6 MWh, leaving an overall annual projected energy saving of 63 MWh.

Actions Planned for 2011

In 2011, Fáilte Ireland hopes to improve our energy performance by undertaking the following initiatives:

- Our ICT division will implement a power consumption monitoring service for our PCs and laptops in our Head Office in Dublin. It is planned to roll out the power saving controls in June 2011. Savings will only be known after 60 days of implementation.
- By changing our print options from laser printers to networked photocopiers we will decrease the number of printers in use in our Head Office in Dublin from 14 down to 8 which we anticipate will generate electricity savings of 2.5 MWh annually.
- It is planned to instigate a power down of all exterior lighting at our Amiens Street premises after office closure each day (provided no security/safety issues arise). It is estimated this will result in 19 MWh of electricity savings annually;
- An EU requirement (EC Reg. 2037/2000) to replace R22 air conditioning units with more environmentally friendly units by 2014 will ensure a reduction in Fáilte Ireland's electrical energy usage as replacement units (e.g. R410A units) are 10% more energy efficient. The replacement of existing R22 units will be phased over 2011 to 2014. Exact MWh savings are undeterminable as dependent on air conditioning usage
- Installation of a calorifier to generate hot water and upgrading the burner for the boiler in our Dublin office; we estimate, will achieve energy savings of 2-3% on the generation of hot water, and 5% savings on heating. Savings of between 13 - 33 MWh of annual natural gas consumption will result.

Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General for presentation to the Houses of the Oireachtas

I have audited the financial statements of the National Tourism Development Authority for the year ended 31 December 2010 under the National Tourism Development Authority Development Act 2003. The financial statements, which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out therein, comprise the Accounting Policies, the Group Income and Expenditure Account, the Group Statement of Total Recognised Gains and Losses, the Group Balance Sheet, the Authority Balance Sheet, the Group Cash Flow Statement and the related notes. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is applicable law and Generally Accepted Accounting Practice in Ireland.

The Authority is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements, for ensuring that they give a true and fair view of the state of the Authority's affairs and of its income and expenditure, and for ensuring the regularity of transactions.

My responsibility is to audit the financial statements and report on them in accordance with applicable law.

My audit is conducted by reference to the special considerations which attach to State Bodies in relation to their management and operation.

My audit is carried out in accordance with the International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) and in compliance with the Auditing Practices Board's Ethical Standards for Auditors.

An audit involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements, sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. This includes an assessment of

- whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Authority's circumstances, and have been consistently applied and adequately disclosed
- the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made in the preparation of the financial statements, and
- the overall presentation of the financial statements. I also seek to obtain evidence about the regularity of financial transactions in the course of audit.

In addition, I read all the financial and non-financial information in the annual report to identify material inconsistencies with the audited financial statements. If I become aware of any apparent material misstatements or inconsistencies I consider the implications for my report.

In my opinion, the financial statements, which have been properly prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice in Ireland, give a true and fair view of the state of the Group's and the Authority's affairs at 31 December 2010 and of the Group's income and expenditure for the year then ended.

In my opinion, proper books of account have been kept by the Authority. The financial statements are in agreement with the books of account.

I report by exception if

- I have not received all the information and explanations I required for my audit, or
- my audit noted any material instance where moneys have not been applied for the purposes intended or where the transactions did not conform to the authorities governing them, or
- the information given in the Authority's Annual Report for the year for which the financial statements are prepared is not consistent with the financial statements, or
- the Statement on Internal Financial Control does not reflect the Authority's compliance with the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies, or
- I find there are other material matters relating to the manner in which public business has been conducted.

I have nothing to report in regard to those matters upon which reporting is by exception.

Statement on Internal Financial Control

On behalf of the Authority Members I acknowledge our responsibility for ensuring an effective system of internal financial control is maintained and operated. The system can only provide reasonable, and not absolute, assurance that assets are safeguarded, transactions authorised and properly recorded, and that material errors or irregularities are either prevented or would be detected in a timely manner.

The Authority has taken steps to ensure an appropriate control environment by:

- clearly defining management responsibilities
- establishing formal procedures for reporting significant control failures and ensuring appropriate corrective action.

A formal process for the identification, evaluation, mitigation and management of business risk has been undertaken and includes:

- the identification and nature of risks
- the likelihood of occurrence
- the financial or other implications
- the mitigating factors
- plans to manage the identified risks
- monitoring and reporting on the process

The system of internal financial control is based on a framework of regular management information, administrative procedures including segregation of duties, and a system of delegation and accountability. In particular it includes:

- Strategic plans and annual budgets which are approved by the Authority.
- High level budget reports reviewing performance against budget which are reviewed at each Authority meeting.
- A Finance Policy Committee, consisting of the Chief Executive and Directors along with the Head of Finance which meets to examine performance against budget and to discuss financial issues affecting the organisation.

- An Internal Audit function which monitors compliance with policies and procedures and the effectiveness of internal controls within the organisation. The Internal Auditor reports to the Chairman of the Audit and Risk Policy Committee.
- An executive Risk Management function which monitors the organisation's progress on risk identified in the Risk Register and reports to the executive.
- An Audit and Risk Management Committee which is made up of three non-executive directors and which meets approximately four times a year to review the Internal Auditor's reports and review the Risk Register, and which reports to the Authority.

The Authority's monitoring and review of the effectiveness of the system of internal financial control is informed by the Internal Auditor, the Audit and Risk Policy Committee which oversees the work of the Internal Auditor, and the executive managers within Fáilte Ireland who have responsibility for the development and maintenance of the financial control framework.

A subsidiary reported an internal fraud which was identified in 2010 resulting in an estimated loss of €14,000.

The subsidiary provided a report on the matter to Fáilte Ireland which detailed the investigation carried out and the action taken against the employee concerned. Controls in the area have been strengthened and the matter was reported to the Gardai.

I confirm that, in respect of the year 31 December 2010, a review of the effectiveness of the system of internal financial control was conducted by the Authority.

Accounting Policies

ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis under the historical cost convention - except for Oireachtas Grants - and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Financial Reporting Standards recommended by the recognised accounting bodies are adopted as they become applicable.

The consolidated financial statements comprise the financial statements of the National Tourism Development Authority and its subsidiary Dublin Regional Tourism Organisation Ltd made up to coterminous period ends.

OIREACHTAS GRANTS

Grants shown in the Income and Expenditure Account reflect the amounts received in respect of the period.

GRANTS PAYABLE

Grant expenditure is recognised in the period in which the recipient carries out the grant activity that creates an entitlement to the grant support and complies with stipulated grant conditions.

FOREIGN CURRENCIES

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are converted into euro at an agreed standard rate for the year. Realised exchange gains and losses on transactions settled during the year are included in the Income and Expenditure Account for the year.

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are converted into euro at exchange rates ruling at the balance sheet date and resulting gains and losses are included in the Income and Expenditure Account for the year.

TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation, charged to the Income and Expenditure Account, is calculated in order to write off the cost of Fixed Assets over their estimated useful lives, at the annual rates set out below:

INVESTMENTS ASSETS

Investment Assets comprise land and buildings with amenity value only and are stated at historic cost.

FINANCIAL ASSETS

All financial assets are included at nominal value.

OPERATING LEASES

Rental payments under operating leases are dealt with in the Income and Expenditure Account as incurred.

CAPITAL ACCOUNT

The Capital Account represents the unamortised value of income used for capital purposes. Transfers between revenue reserves and capital reserves are made annually so as to equate the capital funding of the organisation, including finance leases, to the net book value of its tangible fixed assets.

Accounting Policies

DEBTORS

Known bad debts are written off and specific provision is made for any amounts the collection of which is considered doubtful.

STOCKS

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

PENSION COSTS

Defined Benefit Schemes

Fáilte Ireland operates defined benefit pension schemes which are funded annually on a pay-as-you-go basis from monies provided by Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport and from contributions deducted from staff salaries.

Pension costs reflect pension benefits earned by employees in the period. The costs are shown net of staff pension contributions which are retained by the Authority. An amount corresponding to the pension charge is recognised as income to the extent that it is recoverable and offset by grants received in the year to discharge payment to pensioners in the unfunded scheme and contributions to the funded schemes.

Actuarial gains or losses arising on scheme liabilities and, where applicable, scheme assets, are reflected in the Statement of Total Recognised Gains and Losses and a corresponding adjustment is recognised in the amount recoverable from Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport.

Pension Liabilities represent the present value of future pension payments earned by staff to date. Deferred pension funding represents the corresponding asset to be recovered in future periods from Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport.

Defined Contribution Schemes

Defined contribution pension schemes are available for staff who are not eligible for the unfunded superannuation scheme.

Payments made under the scheme are dealt with in the Income and Expenditure Account of the year to which they relate.

Fáilte Ireland has carried out verification checks on expenditure claimed in a sample of projects supported under the 1994-1999 Tourism Operational Programme and also carries out post-monitoring on grants paid. As a result of these procedures, funds to the value of €996,820 which were recovered from grantees, were on hand and included in Creditors above at year-end. It is anticipated that further recoveries will be made, although it is not possible to estimate the amount at this stage. The total recovered will be repaid to the EU.

Ba í an tuairim i measc oibritheoirí turasóireachta ag túis na bliana 2010 ná go mbeadh dúshlán mhóra i ndán dóibh arís sa bhliain a bhí rompu. Léirigh roinnt mhaith acu, áfach, níos mó muiníne maidir leis an todhchaí agus bhí siad ag súil le beagán cobhsaíochta ar a laghad an bhliain seo chugainn. Ach faraor, níor mhair an dóchas sin i bhfad mar gheall ar an mbliaín a bhí againn.

Leantar le barr feabhas a chur ar an infrastruchtúr turasóireachta a bhúochas sin d'infheistíocht bhereise Stáit. Chomh maith leis sin tá féilire féilte agus spóirt againn anois atá lán le gníomhaíochtaí agus a chlúdaíonn an bhliain ar fad.

Mar sin, tá táirge againn atá ar ardchaighdeán, tá infrastruchtúr níos fearr againn agus tá luach níos fearr á thabhairt againn anois ná mar a bhí riamh cheana. Tá na spriocmhargaí is táirgíúla thar lear aitheanta agus conas mar is féidir tabhairt fúthu. Mar sin, leis na buntáistí sin ar fad, tá sé de chumas ag earnáil na turasóireachta a theacht chuici féin go tapa ach cóir ghaoithe a fháil.

Agus sinn ag fágáil na bliana 2010 inár ndiaidh, táimid ag tnúth go mór leis an mbliaín 2011, mar dealraíonn sé go bhfuil an taoide ag casadh. An bóthar chun fáis ná tulleadh gnó thar lear a fhorbairt, agus ar an tslí sin ginfear tuillimh coigríche agus cothófar poist atá ag teastáil go géar. Tá comharthaí ann, fiú más comharthaí beaga féin atá iontu, go bhfuil feabhas ag teacht ar an ngeilleagar domhanda.

Comhartha maith é sin ó thaobh cruthú post i dtír ina bhfuil an difhhostaíocht mar údar mór imní i láthair na huaire. Is tionscal dlúthfhostaíochta í an turasóireacht agus Fáilteachas, arbh ionann í agus post amháin as gach deich bpost, i bpáirteanna den tír nach

bhfaigheann seirbhís mhaith ó thionscail ar bith eile go minic. Cínteoídh an tábhacht a bhaineann le 'cúram pearsanta', go bhfanfaidh sí ina hearnáil dlúthfhostaíochta agus, má thagann cor chun feabhas suntasach i lón na dturasóirí agus na gníomhaíochta ó thar lear, d'fhéadfadh sé go gcruthófaí poist bhereise. Go deimhin, tá deiseanna nua le haghaidh post á n-aithint againn cheana féin agus táimid ag tacú leo trí ghnóthaí nua éagsúla a thosú.

Oibreoidim leis an tionscal, amach anseo, ar mhaithre leis na factóirí go léir a 'chuidíonn' agus a 'mheallann' an gnó sin a chuideoidh le fás na hearnála. Beimid ag feidhmiú chun 'cuidíú' leo lón níos mó turasóirí a thabhairt chun na tíre trí chláir sainoiriúnaithe a chuideoidh le gnóthaí díolacháin thar lear a thabhairt chun críche. Beidh Fáilte Ireland ag feidhmiú ar feadh na bliana leis an méid is féidir a chur leis na factóirí 'meallta' riachtanacha – le cur le taitneamhacht iomlán a bhaint as an méid atá le feiceáil agus le déanamh sa tir seo – lena chinntí go gcuirfear ardú ar lón na dturasóirí atá tuillte go maith ag táirge na turasóireachta sa tir seo.

Thar ceann an Údaráis, ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabháil le Shaun Quinn agus a fhoreann ar fad i Fáilte Ireland mar gheall ar a dtiomantas agus a ngairmiúlacht i dtacú le tionscal na turasóireachta le linn na bliana 2010.

Ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabhál freisin leis an iarr-Aire Turasóireachta, Cultúr agus Spóirt, Mary Hanafin, Uasal, as ucht na tacaíochta a thug sí don earnáil turasóireachta le linn a tréimhse ina hAire Turasóireachta i 2010. Ba mhaith liom gach rath a ghuí ar an Aire a ceapadh le déanaí, an tUas Leo Varadkar TD, agus ar an Aire Stáit, Michael Ring, TD lena gcúram turasóireachta - táimid ag tnúth le bheith ag obair go dlúth leo.

Tá luach níos mó á chur ar an turasóireacht le blianta beaga anuas mar ghné thábhachtach sa gheilleagar. Tá os cionn 180,000 post agus os cionn €5 billiún á ghiniúint ag an tionscal seo in ioncam agus mar sin, creidim gur sócmhainn náisiúnta ríthábhachtach atá ann. FEIDHMÍOCHT TURASÓIREACHTA

Bhí na blianta seo caite ar na blianta ba dheacra agus ba dhúshlánaí don Turasóireacht in Éirinn le glúin anuas. Tá titim tagtha ar fheidhmíocht na turasóireachta in Éirinn le linn gach bliain de na trí bliana ó 2007 mar thoradh ar drochchoinníollacha eacnamaíochta sna príomhmhargáid idirnáisiúnta agus an cálú géar in eacnamaíocht na hÉireann – tar éis tréimhse sé bliana roimhe sin inar tharla fás leanúnach, suntasach.

Thug an cálú sa turasóireacht athrú mór chun cinn freisin i straitéis agus in oibríochtaí Fáilte Éireann lena chinntí go leanfaidh an eagraíocht le bheith ábhartha go hiomlán i ndáil le riachtanais fiontair thurasóireachta, agus tá deacracht trádála agus oibríochta ag an gcuid is mó acu sin ar bhonn leanúnach.

Meastar gurbh ionann agus 5.9m an líon turasóirí ó tharlear don bhliaín 2010 – 11% níos lú ná 2009. Thit tuillimh mhalartaithe eachtracha 12% freisin sa bhliaín 2010 go dtí iomlán de €3.4 billiún ar feadh na bliana sin.

Laistigh de threocht fhoriomlán na géarchéime, tháinig titim shuntasach 11% ar líon na dturasóirí ó mBreatain mar gheall ar éileamh lag an sterling in aghaidh an euro, agus tháinig titim beagnach 15% ar líon na dturasóirí o Mhórthír na hEorpa; chláraigh na margáí móra Eorpacha ar fad titim dédhigiteach. Bhí an scéala ó na margáí i bhfad ó bhaile chomh dúshlánach céanna, cé nach raibh an titim chomh géar. Tháinig titim go dtí 4% ar thurasóirí ó Mheiriceá

Thuaidh agus tháinig titim réasúnta beag 5% ar mhargaí eile i bhfad ó bhaile.

Tháinig titim bheag sa bhliain 2009 ar an líon turas baile a thóg daoine a chónaíonn in Éirinn i gcomparáid le 2009 ag 8 milliún turas, tháinig titim de 10% go €1.3 billiún ar chaiteachas rud a léiríonn cúngú ioncaim inchaite san eacnamaíocht.

In éagmas na figiúirí oifigiúla le haghaidh laethanta saoire baile, le fios go bhféadfadh foinsí sonraí tánais-teacha ar líon na dturas saoire a bheith cosúil le 2009, tar éis cur isteach ar phatrún taistil de bharr Luathreamhán Bolcánach na hÍoslainne.

Mar sin féin, bhí sástacht custaiméirí le táirge turasóireachta na hÉireann fós ard le linn na tréimhse dúshlánaigh sin. Bhí líon na gcuairteoirí a dúirt go molfad siad go cinnte saoire a chaitheamh in Éirinn an-ard agus sroich sé sin buaicphointe de 88% in 2010, an leibhéal ab airde le cúig bliana anuas.

Chomh maith leis sin, bhí súil ag cuairteoir as gach cúigear (23%) ó tharlear a theacht ar ais laistigh den chéad bhliaín eile agus shamhlaigh os cionn leath de na cuairteoirí ar fad (52%) go dtabharfadh siad cuairt eile sna blianta beaga atá amach romhainn. I gcás 95% den lucht saoire ó tharlear, bhí saoire in Éirinn níos fearr nó chomh maith agus a cheapadar a bheadh sí agus dúirt 98% go molfaidís saoire in Éirinn dá muintir agus dá gcairde. I measc lucht saoire ag baile, bhain na leibhéal sástachta foriomlán 96% amach freisin.

AG TACÚ LE FIONTAIR THURASÓIREACHTA IOMAÍOCH

Chiallaigh na droch-choinníollacha trádála a bhí ann le linn séasúr turasóireachta na bliana 2009 go raibh ar Fáilte Ireland méadú suntasach a dhéanamh ar a gcuid infheistíochta chun tacaíochtaí praiticiúla gnó a sholáthar d'fhiontair thurasóireachta aonair a raibh deacrachtaí acu. Faoi dheireadh na bliana bhí tacaíocht sainoiriúnaithe curtha ar fáil do bheagán níos lú ná *3,000 fiontar thurasóireachta*. Chuimsigh an réimse seirbhísí a cuireadh ar fáil, athstruchtúrú airgeadais, meantóireacht gnó, feabhsú táirgjúlachta, díolachán agus margalócht ríomhthráchtail agus cúram custaiméirí.

Leis an athrú sin ar fhócas a éascú, thug Fáilte Ireland athstruchtúrú mór inmheánach ar a gcuid oibríochtaí réigiúnacha chun críche agus chomhlánaigh siad é trí oiliúint agus forbairt a dhéanamh ar fhoireann feidhmiúcháin ar fud na tíre a bheadh ag idirghníomhú le claint tionscail.

Bhí éileamh láidir ar idirghabhálacha oiliúna le cur le táirgjúlacht laistigh de ghnóthaí aonair de réir mar a bhí oibritheoirí ag streachailt chun fiontair a réachtáil ar bhonn inmhARTHANA le níos lú foirne. Ar an iomlán, chuir Fáilte Ireland tacaíocht dhíreach oiliúna agus forbartha ar fáil do thart ar *5,000 fostáí ón tionscal* ar an láthair, san áit oibre, nó ag ceann de na hionaid oiliúna réigiúnacha. Bhí éileamh ón tionscail chomh hard sin gur athraigh Fáilte Éireann an bhéim ó oiliúint a chur ar fáil d'iontrálaithe nua chuig cuidiú le poist atá ann cheana a chothú.

Ní aon ionadh mar sin, go bhfuil dlús curtha ag an tionchar atá ag an ríomhthráchtáil ar thaisteal agus ar thurasóireacht leis an éileamh láidir ar thacaíocht forbartha fiontar sa réimse sin. Rinneadh seachadadh sa bliaín 2010 ar réimse tacaíochtaí gréasán agus meáin shóisialta trínár *dtionscnamh Ríomhghnó* chun cuidiú le comhaltaí an tionscail a n-acmhainní tráchtála a forbairt trí láithreacht ar líne eifeachtach. D'oibrigh Fáilte Ireland le *760 gnó agus 2,250 feidhmeannach* le

hathbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar fheidhmiúlacht a gcuid láithreáin ghréasáin agus iad a fheabhsú trí Web Check agus Web Check Plus. Chomh maith leis sin, *cuireadh 70 clár oiliúna gréasán* ar fáil le scileanna 1,200 bainisteoir a thabhairt cothrom le dáta agus iad a forbairt i ndáil le forbairt agus feidhmiú gréasáin agus tugadh cúnamh do *45 gnó* ag an gcéim thosaithe trí forbairt a dhéanamh ar láithreán gréasáin dá gcuid fiontar.

Tháinig éileamh níos mó freisin sa bliaín 2010 ar na *seirbhísí meantóireachta* a chuireann Fáilte Ireland ar fáil. Is ar thacaíocht margáiochta agus ar ríomh-mhargalócht ar an láthair is mó a bhí éileamh. Rinne painéal de os cionn *50 meantóir* seachadadh ar *500 idirghabháil* ar an iomlán do *440 gnó*. Chomh maith leis sin, ghlac thart ar *1,350 feidhmeannach tionscail* páirt inár gclár ar forbairt ghairmiúil leanúnach. Bhí sé sin beagnach faoi dhó níos mó ná an leibhéal a taifeadadh sa bliaín 2009 agus san áireamh ansin *24 rannpháirtí bainistíochta sinsearaí* a cháiligh ó *Chlár Bainistíochta Feidhmiúcháin* Fáilte Ireland / Ollscoil Cornell agus bronnadh teastas orthu i "Strategic Hospitality Management" a bhí creidiúnaithe ag Ollscoil Cornell. Chomh maith leis sin, cháiligh *40 bainisteoir sinsearach ó ostáin* sa chlár Marketing Management in Action i mí Bealtaine a seachadadh i gcomhar le Boston College, Massachusetts.

Bhí os cionn *220 gnó* rannpháirteach sa tionscnamh "*Éire a Dhíol Thar Lear*" a bhí ag díriú ar chuidiú le gnóthaí turasóireachta cur lena bhfócas idirnáisiúnta agus tuilleadh gnó a mhealladh ó phríomh-mhargaí thar lear, go háirithe an Ríocht Aontaithe, Stáit Aontaithe Mheiriceá, an Ghearmáin agus an Fhrainc.

FORBAIRT MHARGAIDH

Ag Spreagadh Éileamh Baile

Rinne Fáilte Ireland infheistíocht mhór arís chun an margadh saoire baile a chur chun cinn agus a forbairt mar thoradh díreach ar an laige leanúnach sna príomh-mhargaí thar lear. Léirigh an taighde leibhéal níos mó suime i measc mhuintir na hÉireann saoire a chaitheamh ag baile mar gheall ar na coinníollacha



eacnamaíochta atá againn i láthair na huaire. Mar fhreagra air sin, threisigh Fáilte Ireland a gcuid iarrachtaí le feachtas margáiochta il-mhéain lánpháirtithe Discover Ireland, agus dhírigh ar na meáin náisiúnta agus réigiúnacha, raidió agus teilifís agus ar líne. Rinneadh infheistíocht €4 mhilliún ar an iomlán san fheachtas agus bhí an t-aiseolas ón tionscal dearfach maidir lena thionchar foriomlán ar feidhmíocht gnó.

Cuireadh leis na hiarrachtaí margáiochta sin arís trí chur i bhfeidhm chlár félite agus imeachtaí cultúrtha den scoth a bhí tarraingteach agus chuir sé sin le tarraingteacht go leor de na cinn scríbe ar fud na hÉireann. Lean Fáilte Ireland, mar mhór-urraitheoir, le hinfheistíocht mhór a dhéanamh i bhféilte agus inimeachtaí cultúrtha ar feadh na bliana 2010. Tugadh €3.8m do 228 féile ar feadh na bliana. Thacaigh an clár náisiúnta le 39 féile le hinfheistíocht de €2.7m agus chruthaigh sé sin caiteachas díreach de €29.9 milliún d'eacnamaíochtaí áitiúla. Ríomh taighde a rinneadh sa bliaín 2010 gurbh ionann comhlúach iomlán na gníomhaíochta eacnamaíochta a tháinig ó fhéilte in Éirinn agus €448 milliún don bliaín.

Ag Baint amach Turasóireacht Gnó Idirnáisiúnta d'Éirinn
Lean Fáilte Ireland, mar eagraíocht atá freagach as turasóireacht gnó in Éirinn, le hinfheistíocht mhór a dhéanamh chun tuilleadh comhdhálacha agus cruinnithe idirnáisiúnta a aithint, a mhealladh agus dhaingniú lena reáchtáil in Éirinn. Thacaíomar le 168 comhdháil idirnáisiúnta, le linn na bliana 2008, arbh ionann iad agus os cionn 83,000 toscaire ó thar lear go hÉirinn agus bhí ioncam de thart ar €125 milliún mar thoradh air sin d'eacnamaíochta na hÉireann.

Chuir Fáilte Ireland 93 ambasadóir comhdhála i láthair an Bhiúró Comhdhála, cuireann na hambasadóirí sin Éirinn chun cinn thar lear mar ionad gnó. I dtéarmaí giniúna gnó, is ionann an cumas atá ag na hambasadóirí sin agus 72,000 toscaire le hioncam iomlán de €108m.

Osclaíodh Ionad Comhdhála Baile Átha Cliath go hoifigiúil i Meán Fómhair agus réitigh sé an bealach d'fhás leanúnach, suntasach na turasóireachta gnó in Éirinn. Ag teacht leis an oscailt, d'fháiltigh Fáilte Ireland roimh 120 ceannaitheoir turasóireachta gnó idirnáisiúnta a bhfuil cár mhór orthu, ag imeacht lónraithe turasóireachta gnó, "Buail le Chéile in Éirinn". Ar an iomlán, dealraíonn sé go n-éireoidh go maith leis an earnáil turasóireachta sin. Tá an t-éileamh i bpríomh-mhargaí ag teacht chuige féin agus tá Éirinn i rocht maith i dtéarmaí infrastruchtúratacáiochta, agus tá iomaíochas ag feabhsú.

Ag tacú le hEarnáil Caitheamh Aimsire Nádúrtha na Tíre seo

Tá sé mar phríomhthosaíocht ag Fáilte Ireland anois a chinntíú go bhfuil gnótháí turasóireachta aonair i rocht maith le sciar níos mó de mhargaí turasóireachta idirnáisiúnta a bhaint amach. Cé gur ar Tourism Ireland Ltd, ár gcomhghníomhaireacht, atá an fhreagracht ár bpríomh-mhargaí foinse a fhorbairt, is ar Fáilte Ireland atá an fhreagrachtcabhrú le hoibreoirí turasóireachta 'an margadh a dhéanamh'.

Le linn na bliana 2010, rinne Fáilte Ireland comhordú ar chlár de sheacht gceardlann trádála den chineál 'buail leis an gceannaitheoir'. Ar an iomlán, bhí thart ar 923 gnó turasóireachta Éireannach rannpháirteach sna ceardlanna sin le bualadh le agus le gnó a thabhairt chun críche le 480 príomhionadaíón trádáil taistil idirnáisiúnta. Sholáthair na himeachtaí sin, 25,000 deis cruinnithe réamhshocraithe, ar an iomlán, do na gnóthaí Éireannacha a bhí rannpháirteach iontu.

Mar cheann scríbe atá beag, le



deacrachartaí eacnamaíochta, níl aon teorainn leis an méid a chuireann an ghníomhaíocht sin lenar n-iarrachtaí foriomlána chun ceann scribe margáochta a fhorbairt ar bheagán costas incriminteach. Chuireamar fáilte, sa bhliain 2010, roimh os cionn 1,300 *iriseoir ó 22 spriocmhargadh thar lear*. Áiríodh orthu sin iriseoirí ón teiliúis, raidió, nuachtáin, irisí agus meáin ar líne. Bhí os cionn 5,000 mór-chraolachán agus foilseacháin mar thoradh ar na turais sin, le luach fógraíochta measta de os cionn €200m.

D'oibrigh Fáilte Ireland freisin le hlárnród Éireann agus le Tourism Ireland sa bhliain 2010, le scéim dreasacha a thabhairt isteach agus a chur i bhfeidhm le taisteal saor in aisce a chur ar fáil do thurasóirí idirnáisiúnta níos sine. Bhí an-tóir ar an *Scéim 'Golden Trekker'* le linn na chéad bhliana agus eisíodh thart ar 15,000 ticéad idir Márta agus mí na Nollag.

AG FORBAIRT TÁIRGE NA TURASÓIREACHTA

Braitheann fás na turasóireachta inbhuanaithe ar thaithí uathúil a thabharfadhbh blaiseadh iomlán don turasóir ar an gceantar. Tá ceann scribe ar nós na hÉireann ag brath ar an smaoineamh sin, sé sin taithí uathúil speisialta a chur ar fáil i gcomparáid le factóirí eile níos cineálaí a bhaineann le pleánail saoire ar nós saoire sa ghrian nó sneachta. Tá cur chun cinn agus tacaíocht a thabhairt do thaithí shaoire atá ar ardchaighdeán agus sainiúil lárnach chuige sin chun cinn scribe turasóireachta tábhachtacha ar fud na tíre a chothabháil agus a láidriú. Tacóidh sin le lón cuairteoirí níos mó, méadú ar an achar a phantar in áit agus le caiteachas níos airde agus tacóidh sé sin ar a sheal féin le gnóthaí brabúsacha, le fostáiocht agus le pobail bhríomhara.

Oibríonn lón fairne, laistigh de Fáilte Ireland, le gníomhaíochtaí, taitneamhachaí agus imeachtaí turasóireachta, a fhorbairt agus tacú lena leathnú agus lena bhfeabhsú ar fud go leor earnálacha éagsúla de thionscal na turasóireachta. Is fiú a thabhairt ar aird nach mór dúinn fócas a choinneáil ar ghníomhaíochtaí, taitneamhachaí agus ar imeachtaí mar phríomhthreallús turasóireachta chun na hÉireann. Cé go bhfuil bia

agus cóiríocht chun tosaigh sa díospóireacht ar an turasóireacht de ghnáth, agus go bhfuil siad go deimhin, ina gcroí-chúiseanna le sástacht an turasóra, is annamh leo a bheith ina bpríomhthreallús maidir le cinneadh tomholtóirí cuairt a thabhairt ar Éirinn. Tá sé i bhfad níos dóchúla go ndéanfaí an cinneadh faoi thionchar "gníomhaíochtaí le déanamh agus rudaí le feiceáil" atá cuimsithe de chuid is mó i ngrúpáil gníomhaíochtaí, taitneamhachaí agus imeachtaí. Mar sin, tá sé sin fós mar phríomhfhócas an chláir forbartha táirge.

Rinneadh dul chun cinn mór le linn na bliana 2010 maidir le Straitéis Forbartha Táirge Fáilte Ireland a chur i bhfeidhm, agus tá an Clár Infheistíochta Caipítíl Turasóireachta le sonrú go láidir laistigh de Chlár Caipítíl Phoiblí athbhreithnithe an Rialtais do 2010-2016, a foilsíodh ag deireadh mí lúil. Ceadaíodh 23 tionscadal ar an iomlán sa bhliain 2010 agus thart ar €37m i gcúnamh deontais.

Agus na tionscadail sin á roghnú, bíonn Fáilte Ireland airdeallach an méid is féidir a chur le tionchar eacnamaíochta na sócmhainní turasóireachta atá i bpáirteanna áirithe den téar. Sampla de sin i dtéarmaí forbartha táirge, go mbreithnítear go bhfuil láidreachtaí áirithe ag iarhar na téar maidir le tírdhreach agus radharc téar, siúl & rothaíocht, eachtraíocht éadrom agus ceol agus cultúr traidisiúnta. Breithnítear go bhfuil láidreachtaí áirithe in oirtheag agus in oirdheisceart na téar ó thaobh na staire agus na hoidhreachta, tithe agus gairdíní agus níos ginearálta, oidhreacht thógtha. Ní bhíonn na tuairimí sin láinchinn teangeolaíochta, ach i dtéarmaí gaolmhara tá bailfocht áirithe ag baint leo. Mar sin i gcleachtas infheistíochta, bhí sé sin soiléir sa bhliain 2010 mar gheall ar an mbéim ar thionscadail ar nos Sliabh Liag, Glasbhealach Mór an larthair, Éicea-Pháirc Ghleann na Laoi, agus Carn Uí Néid san iarhar, agus tionscadail ar nos oidhreacht Ghleann na Bóinne, Triantán na Lochlannach, Baile Oidhreachta Chaladh na Carraige, agus Teach agus Gairdíní Bhaile an Chaisleáin san oirtheag.



Is díol suntais freisin go bhfuil gné áirithe de "leas an phobail" ag baint le tionscadail den sórt sin. De ghnáth, ní mar fhiontar ghnó a ghineann brabús atá tacaíocht a fháil ag na fiontair sin, (iontu féin agus astu féin), ach mar gur príomh-thaitneamhachtaí iad a tharraingíonn cuairteoirí chun an cheantair agus mar sin go ngineann siad gnóthachain eacnamaíocha a mbaineann gnóthaí eile sa cheantar leas astu. Ar go leor bealaí, is ionann na tionscadail sin agus infheistíocht in "infrastruchtúr turasóireachta" agus tá siad comhthreomhar le coincheapa atá níos aitheanta ar nós infheistíocht in "infrastruchtúr iompair".

Leanadh le dul chun cinn sa bláthain 2010 ar fheidhmiú an chláir náisiúnta do léirmhíniú agus comharthaíocht bhealaí siúil ár *100 baile stairiúil is mó aird*. Tá oibreacha *tugtha chun críche i 44* de na bailte sin, le mapaí cosán siúil is féidir a íoschóipeáil curtha ar fáil ar láithreán gréasán Discover Ireland. Chomh maith leis sin, cuireadh doiciméad treoiríne ar fáil do bhailte stairiúla agus an bealach inar féidir leo an méid is féidir a chur lena gcumas turasóireachta.

FÁILTEACHAS AGUS CAIGHDEÁIN

Rinne Fáilte Ireland forbairt ar chreat Bia don Turasóireacht d'Éirinn sa bláthain 2010 atá faoi stiúir ag an bhfís go n-aithneoidh cuairteoirí Éire mar gheall ar fáil, ardchaighdeán agus luach ár dtaithí bia áitiúil agus réigiúnach a mhúsclaíonn ómós áite, cultúir agus fáilteachais uathúil.

Rinneadh forbairt ar scéimeanna nua rangaithe agus catagóirithe don earnáil Leaba & Brífeasta Theaghlaigh Éireannach chomh maith le straitéis agus branda nua. Chomh maith leis sin cuireadh scéim ceadaithe nua d'earnáil an ghailf i bhfeidhm agus tá *60 cursa* ceadaithe go dtí seo.

Ghlac ar an iomlán *50 foras nua* páirt sa Chlár Optimus – clár cáilíochta seirbhise Fáilte Ireland - agus bhain siad leas as raon idirghabhálacha forbartha lena n-áirítear ceardlanna meantóireachta, oiliúna agus caighdeáin.

Ar shraith eile atá tábhachtach i dtéarmaí tacaíochtaí fáilteachais tá an obair a dtugann Fáilte Ireland fúithi le tacú le scileanna agus le fostáiocht sa tionscal. Tugtar tacaíocht do raon leathan cláir oideachais agus oiliúna i ndeich Institiúid Teicneolaíochta ar fud na tíre. Cuireann na cláir sin oiliúint atá ábhartha don tionscal ar fáil i réimsí ar nós scileanna cócaireachta, seirbhís bhialainne, scileanna beáir, bainistiú ofig thosaigh agus bialainne. Rinne Fáilte Ireland infheistíocht de €4.3m sa bláthain 2010 i gcur le scileanna ábhartha turasóireachta do thart ar 1,920 mac léinn in earnáil na nInstitiúid Teicneolaíochta.

POLASAÍ AGUS AN TODHCHAÍ

Thug Fáilte Ireland faoi thionscadail taighde éagsúla agus faoi staidéir eile sa bláthain 2010 ar mhaithle le réasúnaíocht bunaithe ar eolas a chur ar fáil do phleanáil tionscnaimh turasóireachta sa todhchaí.

Tugadh faoi cheithre shraith den Suirbhé Tomhais Turasóireachta, ag tomhas tuairimí an tionscail i ndáil le feidhmíocht go dtí sin sa bláthain agus cad a bhí i ndán don tionscal amach anseo. Rinneadh tomhas leanúnach ar fheidhmíocht óstán agus earnálacha cóiríochta eile i rith na bliana freisin. Chomh maith leis an bpróifíliú leanúnach ar thurasóirí baile trí shuirbhéanna náisiúnta, rinneadh próifíliú ar chuaireoirí ó thar lear freisin trí shuirbhéanna ag na príomhchalafoirt farraige agus aer. Coimisiúnaíodh obair freisin chun monatóireacht a dhéanamh ar cé chomh héifeachtach is a bhí an feachtas fógraíochta saoire ag baile.

Rinne Fáilte Ireland seachadadh ar leor tionscadal an bláthain seo caite a bhí deartha le torthaí a bhí bául don turasóireacht a bhaint amach ar raon saincheisteanna. Airíodh orthu sin:

- Bileog threorach agus anailse ar acmhainneacht iomarcach earnáil na n-óstán.
- Forbairt modheolaíochtaí meastóireachta le hathbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar fheidhmíocht sna príomh-chinn scríbe turasóireachta



- Athbhreithniú ar thurasóireacht chultúir agus ar institiúidí cultúir in Éirinn
- Treoir do bhailte stairiúil maidir leis an mbealach leis an méid is féidir a chur lena gcumas turasóireachta.

D'oibríomar freisin ar thionscadail chomhoibriúcha a bhí bául leis an turasóireacht le Cumann Bialanna na hÉireann, Cónaighim na nÓstán Éireannach, an Cónaighim Thionscal Turasóireachta na hÉireann agus raon fíelte náisiúnta ar nós Fhéile Ealaíon na Gaillimhe agus Fleá Cheoil na hÉireann. Tugadh chun críche staidéar a bhí dírithe ar an todhchaí maidir le tionchar meántéarmach ar an tionscal ó thaobh forbairt déimeagrafacha agus forbairtí sóisialta eile.

TURASÓIREACHT AGUS AN TIMPEALLAHT

Lean Fáilte Ireland sa bhliain 2010 leis an timpeallacht nádúrtha agus tógtha a chur i gcroílár polasaí agus cleachtas na turasóireachta inbhuanaithe. Ag comhlíonadh ár ról mar chomhlacht forordaithe faoi na hAchtanna Pleanála, rinne Fáilte Ireland aighneachtaí maidir leis na hocht gcinn de Threoiríntle Pleanála Náisiúnta, sé cinn de phleananna forbartha contae agus cathrach, 18 iarratas pleanála agus 41 Measúnachtaí Tionchair Timpeallachta faoi scópáil iarratas. I ngach ceann de na haighneachtaí seo, chuir Fáilte Ireland chun cinn cur chuige inbhuanaithe ó thaobh fhorbairt turasóireachta ina bhféachtar leis an tsócmhainn ar a mbraitheann an tionscal a chosaint.

Lean Aonad Timpeallachta Fáilte Ireland freisin ag cuidiú le gnótháí turasóireachta aonair ó thaobh a gcuid iarrachtaí tomholtas fuinnimh agus an méid uisce a úsáidtear araon a laghdú agus a gcuid dramhaíola a bhainistiú níos fearr. Foilsíodh treoirlínte timpeallachta don earnáil turasóireachta gnó agus do na hionaid eachaíochta, go háirithe, agus reáchtáil Fáilte Ireland clár píolótach i gCiarraí agus fuair 55 gnó turasóireachta teastasú gnó agus foilsíodh Treoir Ghlas don Ring of Kerry mar thoradh air sin. Chomh maith leis sin, tugadh cothrom le dáta an treoir achoimre do

ghnóthaí turasóireachta chun a gcuid costais thimpeallachta a laghdú.

CONCLÚID

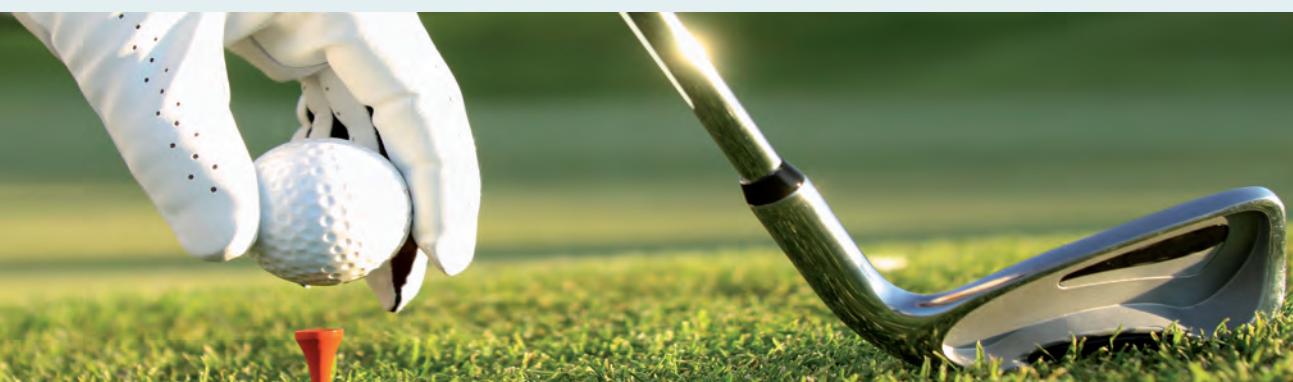

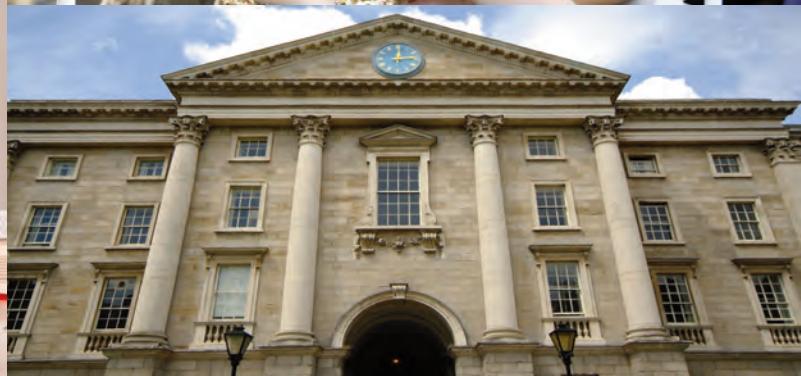

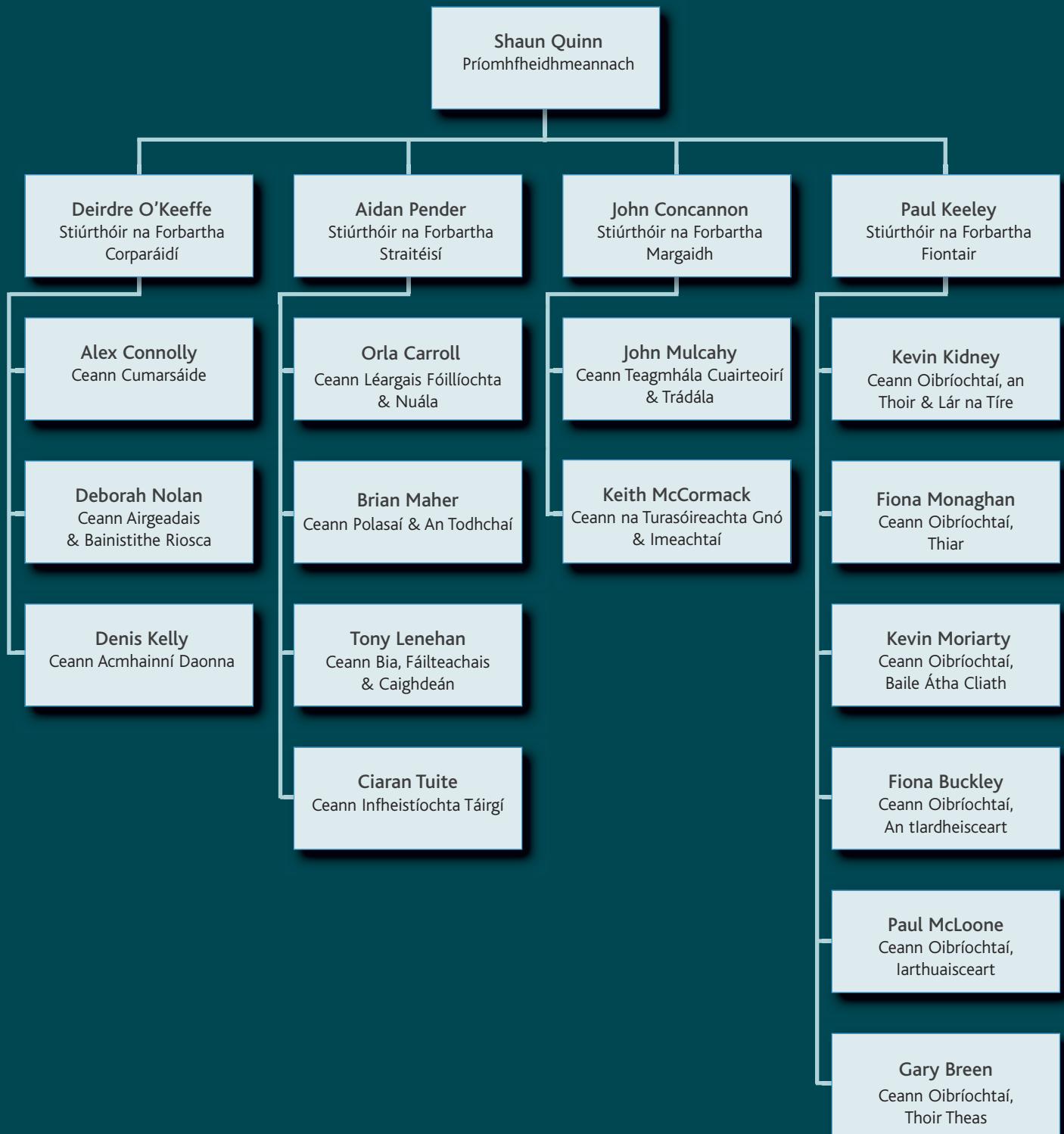
