

EU Just Transition Fund Regenerative Tourism Scheme 2023-2026

Ireland will receive up to **€84.5million** from the EU Just Transition Fund over the period to 2026.

With match funding from the Government of Ireland, a fund of up to **€169million** is available.

Fáilte Ireland has been allocated **€68million** from this fund to deliver a Regenerative Tourism Scheme for Ireland's midlands.

What is the EU Just Transition Fund?

The EU's Just Transition Fund is a fund created under the 2021-2027 programming round. It operates under Regulation (EU) 2021/1056 within the framework of the EU Cohesion policy.

The Fund's objective is to **support the regions and communities in Europe that are most negatively affected by the transition to climate neutrality**, ensuring that no one is left behind.

The EU Just Transition Fund aims to address **employment, economic, social and environmental** impacts that come with the shift away from carbon-intense activities.



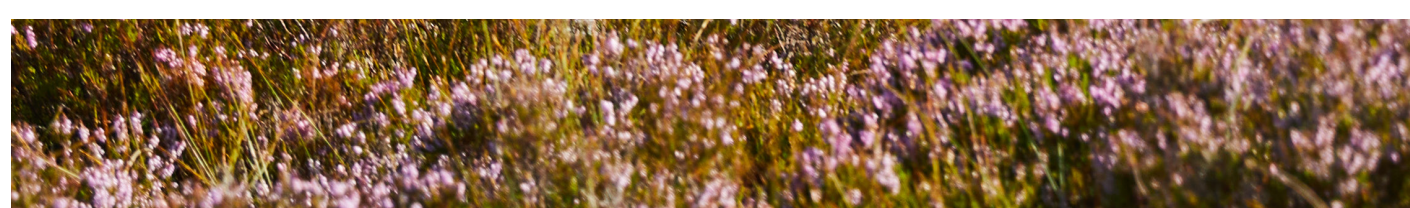
Key Priorities for EU Just Transition Fund 2023-2026

GENERATING



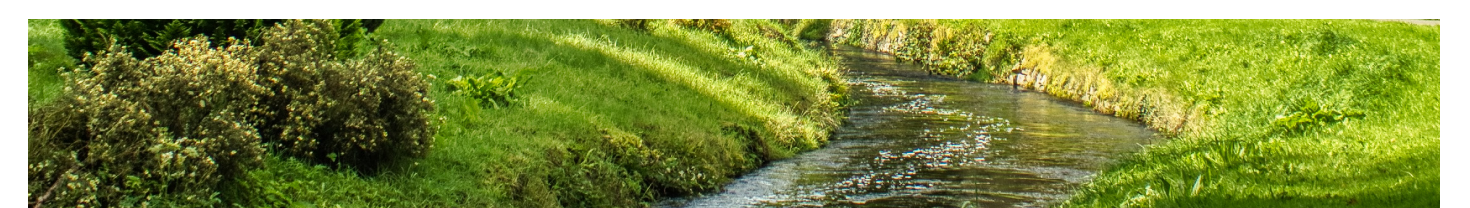
Generating employment for former peat/fossil fuel communities by investing in the diversification of the local economy.
