- Support research, development and innovation activities



Support the regeneration and repurposing of peatlands and related land

Key Actions:

- Under this priority, the Programme will support a set of actions for rehabilitation, regeneration and repurposing of peatlands and associated lands that will no longer be used for the extraction, transport and processing of peat.
- These actions will complement the activities under Priority 1 by providing employment for impacted workers and communities and by making the Territory a more attractive place to live, work and visit.





Key Actions:

• As part of this priority, the EU JTF Programme will enhance sustainable and clean mobility in the Territory by supporting



actions focusing on the decarbonisation of transport to provide clean transport solutions to the people working, study-ing and visiting the EU JTF Territory.
